


NotAnExperiment Trivia

This fun game engages high school students while they learn about the effects of vaping nicotine and cannabis. It can be used as a stand-alone game or be included in **Clouds Display** activities.

Creating a game kit

Print and cut the double-sided trivia cards located on the resource section of the Educators page.

Use an online spinning wheel tool (such as **spinthewheel.io**) for students to spin their trivia card colour.

Use game buzzers or have students place their hands on a target to signal they have an answer.

Set Up

Enter the trivia card colours on the online spinning wheel tool.

Place cards in stacks based on their colours.

Set out buzzers or target.

How to play

Use the buzzers for some friendly competition. Play with 2-3 students at a time. Be prepared; they will ask to play more than once.

The participant spins the online wheel.

- A colour is selected via the spinner. A card matching the colour is chosen from the deck.
- Two students hover over their respective buzzer or target, each ready to answer the fastest.
- The participant reads the question card aloud.
- Students compete by hitting their respective buzzers or the target when they have an answer.
- Further discuss the student's answer as appropriate, using the answer on the reverse of the card.
- Place the used card at the bottom of its coloured set.

If there is only one player, the player will spin and draw a card as before. However, the player answers the question in their own time.

If there are groups of 3-4 & two trivia games are available: they can all play at once using the three or four buzzers or targets.
